


COMMERCIAL REAL ESTATE AWARDS

WITH the company's growth and need for expansion, Stamps.com purchased Grand Avenue Plaza in El Segundo. The main goals for the new headquarters were to promote collaboration and teaming. The new hardscape entry design includes an impactful water feature that provides a grand sense of arrival. Large expanses of a two-story curtain wall capture the space between the two existing buildings.
